

Food in School

Children bring packed lunches to school which may also contain a mid-morning break. Except in emergencies and on special occasions, the school does not undertake to supply food to the children. Water from a drinking fountain is available throughout the day.

All lunchboxes should be airtight and clearly named.

Because of the risk to some children of severe allergic reaction, it is asked that no nuts are brought in to school and, as far as is reasonably possible, no food with nut additive is included in lunchboxes.
